The Summit was started by a welcome speech by Mr. Kumaar Bagrodia, followed by the opening address by Dr. AK

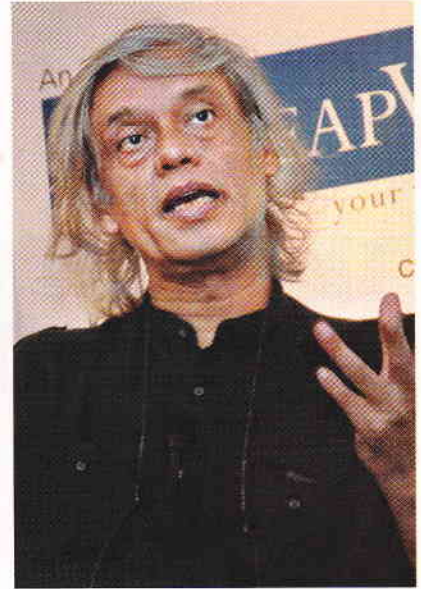
